ULSTER BRANCH REGISTRATION

All players must be registered with the Irish Rugby Football Union. If your son is not already registered through Instonians the follow are necessary:

- 1) A photocopy of the player's birth certificate/passport and a passport sized photograph.

2) Any player who was previously registered at another club or who plays a rugby at a school which plays in the Schools Cup will also require a Club/Schools Release form to be completed by the former club and/or the school Principal. These forms can be downloaded and returned to the team manager as early in the season as possible.
